

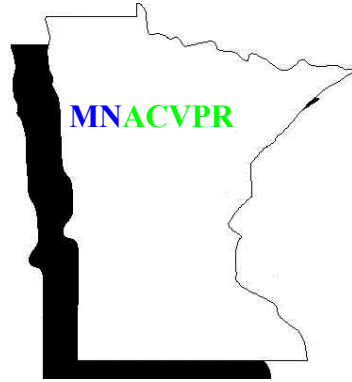
OVERVIEW
